The Grandes Semaines of the SHF 2022

Over two years after the start of the health crisis, here we are with a complete year of competitions under our belt coming to an end at the National Finals. In every discipline, each rider, breeder, owner, groom, organizer, judge and the lists goes on... they have all taken part so that this season was a memorable one and it made up for the past few challenging years.

The SHF (French Equine Society), the mother-society of young sport horses and ponies, is delighted to welcome you again to its national finals in seven disciplines: Show Jumping, Eventing, Dressage, Carriage Driving, Endurance, Hunter Style and PRATIC.

With a noticeable rise in births in 2018, we are more than pleased at the number of 4 year olds that have participated on our circuit throughout this season and we cannot wait to see them in action here at the Finals. Dates to add to your calendar:

Sologn'Pony at Lamotte-Beuvron (41)) from 17th to 20th August
Show Jumping for 4, 5 and 6 year old C and D ponies - (C pony = 131-140cm / D pony= 141cm-148cm)

The Grande Semaine de CSO/Hunter (Show Jumping/Hunter) at Fontainebleau (77) du 26 août au 4 septembre
Show Jumping, Cycle Libre 1st, 2nd and 3rd year and Cycle Classique 4, 5, 6 and 7 year olds. Hunter Style 4, 5, 6 year old horses and ponies.

The Grande Semaine de Concours Complet (Eventing) at Pompadour (19) from 21st to 25th September
Eventing: Cycle Libre 1st, 2nd and 3rd year and Cycle Classique 4, 5 and 6 year old horses 4, 5 and 6 year old D ponies.

The Grande Semaine de Dressage at Saumur (49) from 29th September to 2nd October.
Dressage: Cycle Classique 4, 5 and 6 year old horses, Cycle Libre 1st, 2nd and 3rd year, 4, 5 and 6 year old ponies.

The Grande Semaine d' Attelage (Carriage Driving) at Lamotte-Beuvron from 1st to 2nd October
Carriage Driving: Horse and pony Cycle Libre Training and Qualification / PRATIC for 3 to 6 year olds.

The Grande Semaine d'Endurance at Uzès (30) from 6th to 9th October
Endurance: 4, 5 and 6 year old Cycle Libre Speed Round

The Grande Semaine de Fontainebleau

40! This year we are celebrating the Grande Semaine de Fontainebleau's 40th edition, yet again at the heart of the renowned Grand Parquet Equestrian Stadium.

The exhibitors village has been completely redesigned around the large and beautiful Carriere des Princes arena, which has become the epicenter of the event since last year. New spaces have been created to improve the ergonomics and functionality of the event:

- The riders' guests will benefit of a reserved viewing area to be able to watch their protégés up close.
- The event's partners will have a close and private access to the arena to make the most of the splendid view.
- The press will benefit from a room with a view on the main arena placed at the heart of the event. A TV set style set-up will be available to allow interviews to take place and shows during the Grande Semaine.

We are expecting thousands of equine enthusiasts, professionals and amateurs to celebrate French breeding with us over the 9 days of competition! First to take to the arena on the first weekend are the Cycle Libre participants, battling it out to be crowned Champion in the 5 available categories. The Grande Semaine continues with the Cycle Classique Championships (4 to 6 year olds) while the 2 to 3 year old Female Events, put forward by the Selle Français studbook, take place. At the end of the week, the 7 year old Championship takes place then the Hunter Style events for horses and ponies finish off the event in style.

This grand horse and enthusiast meet-up represents nearly 1700 equines and their teams from all over France: riders, grooms, owners, breeders and many more. The Grande Semaine de Fontainebleau is a culmination of a year's work for the horse and its team, who have high hopes for this final.

Designed as a training opportunity for young sport horses, this circuit is also a promotion and marketing aid for many professionals. This great breeding celebration organised by the SHF has established itself as an essential stepping stone for all horses intended for show jumping or hunter style competition. Every year, breeders, dealers and riders meet at the Grand Parquet to present the best horses of each age category and promote them for future marketing, or to improve genetics in the French breeding system.

La Grande Semaine de Fontainebleau

Every year since 2017, the SHF-video platform will be live streaming all events. The riders and owners will have access to these videos on their Compte SHF account and share them directly to potential buyers. International visibility is available to our members thanks to the transmission on the GrandPrix.tv and ClipMyHorse.tv platforms during the whole week of the Grand Semaine. For the first time ever, ChevalTV will live stream on its channel the 5, 6 and 7 year old Finals showcasing the evolution of French breeding.

Owners will once again use SHF-market.com to put their horses up for sale during the event. The Grande Semaine online catalogue regroups all the ads for horses for sale participating in the event. It will be available on the website once entries are closed. A special jingle will be played indicating that the horse is for sale, there will also be an announcement from the speaker as the couple enters the arena.



Rules & Regulations modifications 2022



In Cycle Classique Show Jumping, there have been many rules and regulations modifications this year.

The most important change was undoubtedly the removal of fetlock boots during the season following significant abuse by certain participants. This difficult decision was made out of concern for animal welfare and the protection of our young horses.

The calculation of the CIR Championships has been revised for the 4 and 5 year old horses. Previously, the in hand showing decided between the double clear horses that were tied. From now on, the rank of the horse in the top 100 is taken into account for the tiebreaker in order to favor the sporting side over the physical characteristics.

A technical regulatory innovation should also be noted for the CIRs and Final: the presence of a mandatory wall jump for the CIRs and Final, but also recommended for the regional competitions. This evolution of the courses was requested with the aim of showing horses the possible solid obstacles that they could face later in their sporting career. Teaching them from an early age, allowing them not to discover them during major events and thus avoiding any unpleasant surprises.

Last modification to take into account on the course of the Final: the small Finals for 5 and 6 year olds have been removed, offering more space for the Final.

Finally, in **Cycle Libre** Show Jumping, the rules have taken into account that the last few years have been difficult for amateurs to take their horses to competitions. The Cycle Libre 1 regional events have therefore been opened to late-starting 6 year old horses. The Regional Finals for 4 year old and first year 5 year old horses are now decided between Top 100, thus distinguishing the best and thereby creating CL1-4, CL1-5 and CL2-5 Regional Champions. Qualification for the National Final was opened up to the Formation and Hunter Style events, which count for 30% of the minimum earnings necessary to qualify. Finally, the Top100 classification will also come into play during the Final to place the couples that are tied after the second or third round.

Modifications réglementaires Style Hunter 2022



In Hunter Style, fetlock boots have also been removed following the decision taken in Show Jumping. On the technical side, the two courses presented in the arena may be carried out in a different order between the two events.

This modification will be compulsory during the Final and will thus make it possible to gauge the reaction and the flexibility of the young horse. Bases are mandatory under each obstacle to maintain a solid appearance. For ponies, the heights have been increased by 10cm. Finally, the judging grid has been revised to make it easier for judges and riders to understand.



Qualification Criteria

Based on the Top 100 since last year, nothing has changed regarding the qualification criteria for the SHOW JUMPING events this year.

CYCLE CLASSIQUE SHOW JUMPING

4, 5 and 6 year old horses are qualified according to the TOP 100 on 8th August 2022 on <https://www.shf.eu/fr/top100/>.

This year, the Grande Semaine has become a one of a kind Championship! As with all major events, horses must remain on site and are not permitted to leave for the duration of their competition. Similarly, in order to ensure a stable for all horses taking part in the Finals, the number of horses per age category has been set:

- 250 for 4 year olds
- 350 for 5 year olds
- 250 for 6 year olds

The qualification criteria has therefore been reviewed to meet this quota of horses. A selection will be made in order to designate, according to age, the 250 or 350 finalists: the day after the entries have closed, the SHF will select among these participants, the best horses according to their ranking in the Top 100 who will have the chance to participate in this 40th edition of the Grande Semaine de Fontainebleau.

QUALIFICATION CRITERIA ACCORDING TO THE TOP 100 RANKING

Cycle Classique 4 years old

- SF/AA : top ranked 450
- ASB : top ranked 100

The 210 best SF/AA horses and the 40 best ABS horses in the Top 100 entered will be selected to participate in the National Final. Entries for non-selected horses will be refunded, notified by email (within 48hours after closing).

Cycle Classique 5 years old

- SF/AA : top ranked 550
- ASB : top ranked 150

The 300 best SF/AA horses and the 50 best ABS in the Top 100 entered will be selected to participate in the National Final. Entries for non-selected horses will be refunded, notified by email (within 48hours after closing).

Les barres de qualification

Cycle Classique 6 years old

- SF/AA : top ranked 450
- ASB : top ranked 100

The 210 best SF/AA horses and the 40 best ABS horses in the Top 100 entered will be selected to participate in the National Final. Entries for non-selected horses will be refunded, notified by email (within 48hours after closing).

CYCLE LIBRE SHOW JUMPING

4, 5 and 6 year old horses are qualified according to the TOP 100 on 16th August 2021, the deadline date for entries for the National Cycle Libre Show Jumping Final, published on <https://www.shf.eu/fr/top100/>.

CYCLE LIBRE 1

- CL1 - 4 ans : top ranked 180
- CL1 - 5 ans : top ranked 180

CYCLE LIBRE 2

- CL2 - 5 ans : top ranked 200
- CL2 - 6 ans : top ranked 180

CYCLE LIBRE 3

- CL3 : top ranked 200

HUNTER STYLE HORSES

To be admitted to the National Final the young horses must have achieved, in the young horse Hunter Style category- to which it belongs (4, 5 or 6 year olds):

- Either a first prime “bonus” (score equal to/or greater than 16),
- Or 2 second primes “bonuses” (score greater or equal to 14 but lower than 16)

HUNTER STYLE PONIES

To be admitted to the National Final, the young pony must have:

- Taken part in a minimum of 1 round in a Young Horse Hunter Style or Young Pony Hunter Style competition with a minimum score of 14/20 on a hunter course.

The Hunter Style Finals



The Cycle Libre Hunter Style events are broken down by age category. This discipline consists of completing an obstacle course with the most fluidity possible. The jumping style, balance, gaits, pace, model and grooming of the horse is judged by the SHF jury.

The final takes place for 4, 5 and 6 year old horses and ponies, as follows :

- The first event is made up of 2 successive rounds. Different courses.
- The second event is also made up of 2 rounds (different courses). The starting order takes place in reverse to the ranking of the 1st event.
- Then an event in “model, distinction and aptitude for the discipline” for all horses and ponies.



The Cycle Classique Show Jumping Finals



The Cycle Classique circuit is open to 4, 5 and 6 year old horses. Each age category benefits from a round adapted to their level of competition in order to train and develop the new generations of sport horses.

Once their entry ticket to Fontainebleau is obtained, the horses will still have to battle it out in the qualifying events (not timed and without a jump-off). Only the best of each age category will have the chance to participate in the grand final and enter the championship standings. For the unqualified horses, a small final is organised.

SF-AA-CSAN CHAMPIONSHIPS PROCEEDINGS

FOR THE 4 YEAR OLDS :

- 250 qualified
- 1 qualifying round with a style and dressage score
- 1 final for horses that have a clear round in the qualifying round and have participated in the in hand showing model test during the final
- 1 small final for the horses who did not qualify for the final

FOR THE 5 YEAR OLDS :

- 350 qualified
- 2 qualifying rounds with a style and dressage score on each round
- 1 in-hand presentation event “model, gaits and condition” for the Top 70
- 1 final for the Top 90 stallions/geldings and mares combined



FOR THE 6 YEAR OLDS :

- 250 qualified
- 2 qualifying rounds
- 1 in-hand presentation event “model, gaits and condition”, for the Top 60 stallions/geldings and mare combined
- 1 Final for the Top 60 stallions/geldings and mares combined

For 6 year olds, at the end of the qualifying rounds, only the top 60 horses are qualified, to which are added those with double-clear rounds and the winners (best female and best gelding/male) of the qualifying events.

For all age groups, a separate classification is established according to sex: a mare classification and a stallion/gelding classification.

NATIONAL FINALS IN OTHER STUDBOOKS

Qualifying events and specific finals are organised for horses belonging to other Studbooks. They take place just before the SF-AA-CSAN horse events.

For 4 year olds, the events take place in one qualifying event, a final and a small final.

5 and 6 year old horses are split over two qualifying events to qualify for the final or the small final.

The penalty system of the events are identical to the SF-AA-CSAN horse events.



7 year olds National Championship



For many years now, the Fédération Française d'Équitation (French Equestrian Federation) has entrusted the SHF with the organisation of the 7 year olds French Championship, which is included in the Grande Semaine de Fontainebleau. This Championship is open to the Top 200 7 year old horses on the qualifications list taken from the permanent classification of the 7 year olds Grand Prix.

This qualification list classifies the 7 year old horses according to their performance in the first quarter of the Top 7 national and international events.

The qualification list starts on 1st January 2022 and ends on Sunday 14th August 2022.

The French Championship unfolds in 3 rounds including a 2 round final :

Thursday 1st September : Jumps and Barème A course type, judged on Barème C

*Barème A: all refusals, knocked poles, run-outs ,etc... is equal to 4 penalty points.

*Barème C: all refusals, knocked poles, run-outs, etc... is equal to time penalty points.

Saturday 3rd September : Barème A not timed, without jump-off (speed 375 m/mn)

Sunday 4th September : final in two rounds with Barème A, not timed (speed 375 m/mn)

- **1st round:** only the Top 40 couples can compete in the first round of the third stage, following the two previous stages. In the event of a tie for 40th place, all 40th ranked are selected.

- **2nd round:** it can take place on a shorter and higher course. The Top 20 competitors from the first two stages and the first round of the third stage are qualified for the second round (of the third stage). In the event of a tie for 20th place, all 20th ranked couples are selected.

The couple having cumulated the fewest penalty points at the end of the classification of the three stages will be declared Champion.

In the event of a tie for first, second and/or third place, the competitors participate in a jump-off against the clock. For information: a general extra classification, without bonus, will be carried out for the male horses.

The Cycle Libre Show Jumping Events



The Cycle Libre is intended for amateur riders who wish to educate their young horses on training courses taking place mainly at weekends. This formative cycle takes place over 3 years :

- **Cycle Libre 1st year for 4 and 5 year old horses (CL1-4 et CL1-5)**
- **Cycle Libre 2nd year for 5 and 6 year old horses (CL2-5 et CL2-6)**
- **Cycle Libre 3rd year for 6 year old horses (CL3)**

5 year old horses are allowed to compete in the Cycle Libre 1 Final as long as they have not participated in this category during their 4th year.

6 year old horses are allowed to compete in the Cycle Libre 2 Final as long as they have not competed for more than two years. However, “upgrading” is also an option. A 5 year old horse can compete in CL2 even if it has not competed in his 4th year or a 6 year old horse can compete in CL3 while it is only in its second year of competition.

For 4 and 5 year old horses in their 1st year, the competition consists of two rounds. The first round, which is not timed, is added to a dressage and style score awarded by specialised SHF judges. The first third is then selected for the final while the other two thirds participate in the small final, both without time. The bonus points obtained during regional finals help to decide between the couples. They can obtain between 0.5 and 2 points depending on their results: 0.5 points for 4 penalty points and 1 point for a clear round, as the regional final is comprised of 2 rounds.

The 5 year old horses in their 2nd year compete in their final over three days with 3 rounds. The two qualifying events are done without time with a final for the first third ranked or a small-final for the remaining two-thirds, also without time. The two qualifying events serve as a guideline for the dressage and jumping scores, which awards two scores to the competitors and thus deciding who goes to the Grand Final on Sunday. The bonus points obtained during the regional final will undeniably play an important role in this ranking where each point is crucial to achieve victory.



6 year old horses in their 2nd and 3rd year compete over three days: two qualifying rounds then the final or the small final. The first round is contested without a set time and ranks all clear rounds in first place. The second round is against the clock, a tie-breaker for any tied couples. The final is run against the clock by the first third of ranked horses in the aggregate of the first and second rounds. The remaining two thirds take part in the small final, also against the clock.

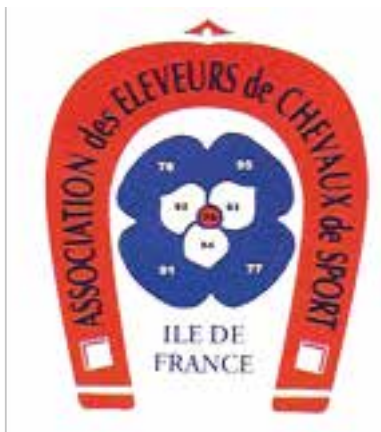
Thus, in parallel with the Classique Show Jumping and Hunter Style National Finals, you will also be able to attend:

The Selle Français Females Event



The Selle Français studbook will be present during the Grande Semaine de Fontainebleau, for the Females Event: the national final for future broodmares and competitors. Tuesday 30th August and Wednesday 31st August: the 2 and 3 year old fillies, selected from all over France, are presented in hand for model and gaits but also in free jump, along with criteria of their genetic value. In each age category, the mare with the best scores obtains the title Champion of France.

The Association Régionale des Éleveurs d'Ile de France competition (ADECSIF)



For many years, the Ile-de-France regional association, the ADECSIF, organises their regional foal competition during the Grande Semaine. The purpose of this competition is to judge and select pony and horse foals of all breeds under the age of 1. For breeders, Sunday 4th September is an opportunity to showcase their breeding, compare their products and discuss the different origins.

A moment of sharing between breeders whether they are amateurs or professionals, ideal and necessary to better French genetics and thrive for excellence!

The video service available to the breeding industry

In 2022, the SHF video service goes into its 6th year of existence. It has now become an essential tool for professionals in this industry. Since 2017, the platform has recorded 220 000 videos at SHF competitions!

This season, over **80 young horse events** have been covered by SHF video. As always, the CIR Cycle Classique Show Jumping and the Grandes Semaines are broadcasted live on the shf-video.com web platform and mobile app.

During the Grande Semaine de Fontainebleau, all arenas will be **broadcasted live**. The SHF stand will allow everyone to see or review the rounds on the SHF video screens. Thanks to the big screen positioned behind the new and improved Carrière des Princes arena, the live stream will be accessible to all visitors.

All the videos are available on the owners' and riders' SHF accounts, as well as on www.shf-video.com, via a subscription or unit purchase.

This marketing aid is one of the three missions carried out by the mother society. The SHF has set up the SHF-video service to complement the SHF-market service. The advertisements of young horses and ponies for sale are showcased with videos taken during the competition season.

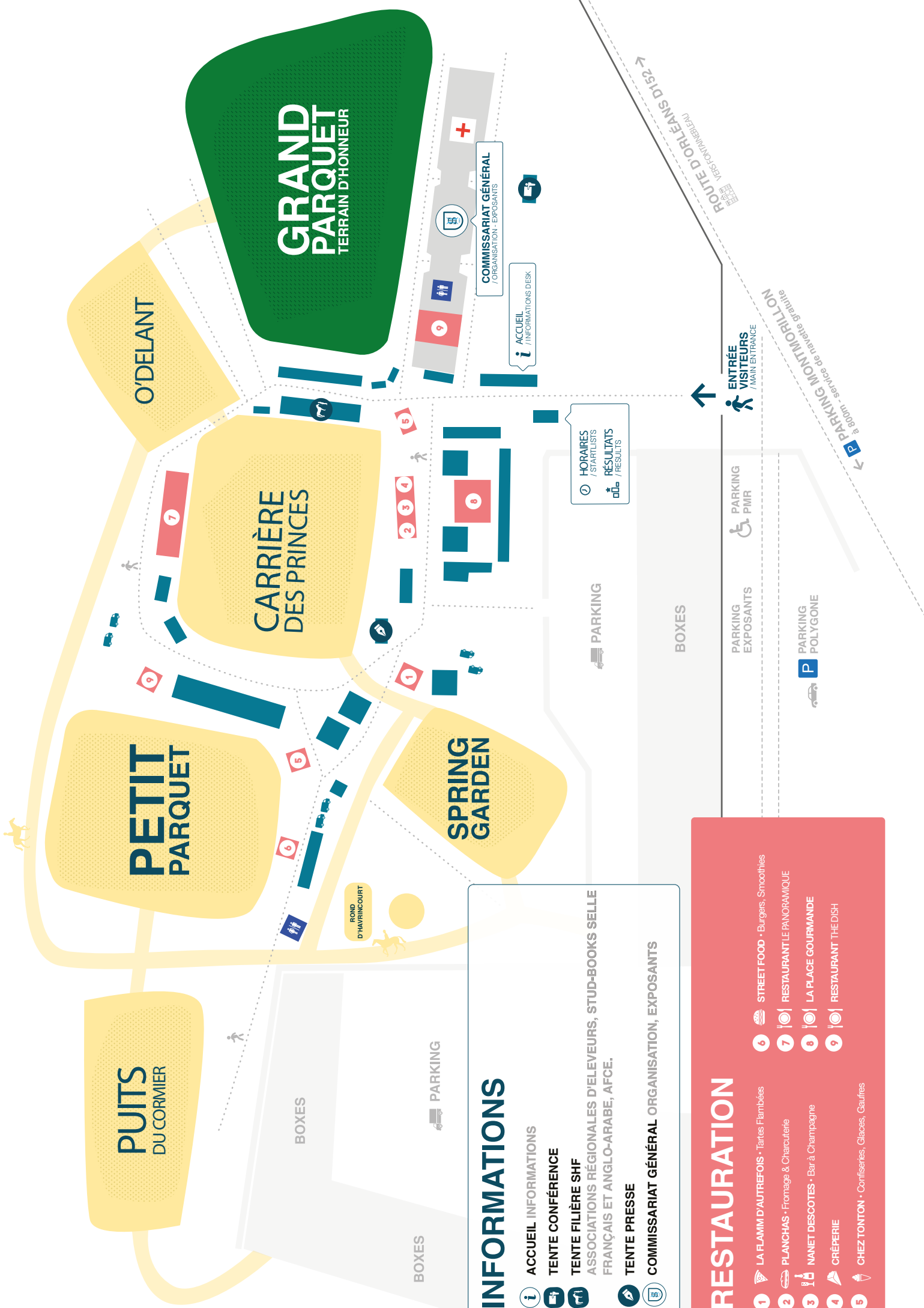
